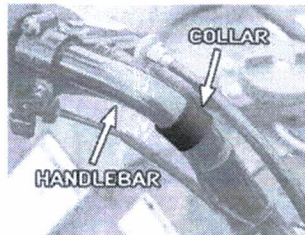

*For ease of installation and windshield placement, leave all hardware loose until final position of windshield is achieved.

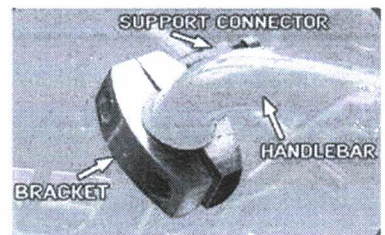
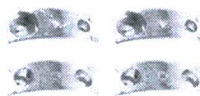
#1 Install plastic collars [Part #1] on handle bars where the handle brackets [Part #2] will be located.

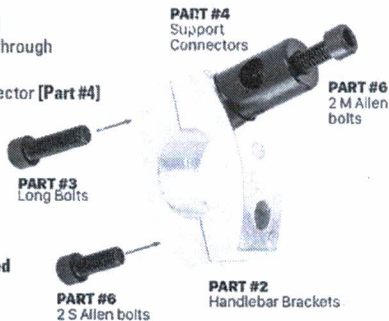


#2 Install handle bar brackets [Part #2] over the plastic collars [Part #1] on the handlebars.

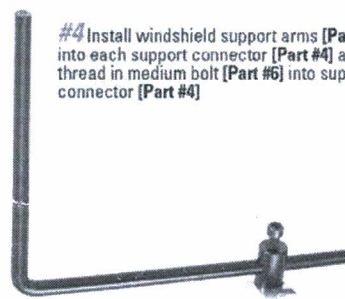


#3 Use the long bolt [Part #3] & Short S bolt [Part #6] to go through handlebar brackets [Part #2] and thread into support connector [Part #4]



*Make sure support connector [Part #4] is seated in the recessed hole of the handlebar clamp [Part #2]

#4 Install windshield support arms [Part #5] into each support connector [Part #4] and thread in medium bolt [Part #6] into support connector [Part #4]

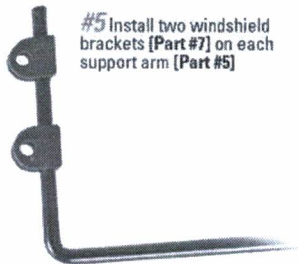

#5 Install two windshield brackets [Part #7] on each support arm [Part #5]



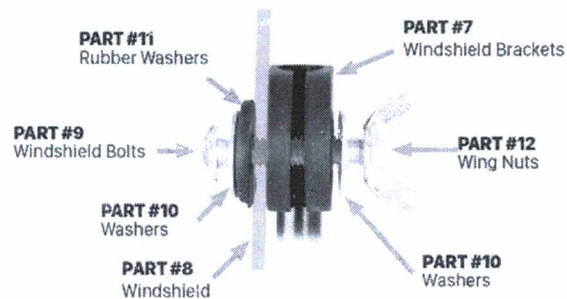

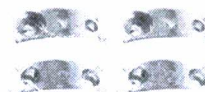
#6 Install the windshield [Part #8] to the support arms [Part #5] with metal washer [Part #10] and rubber washer [Part #11] through windshield [Part #8] and windshield bracket [Part #7] Secure with metal washer [Part #10] and wing nut [Part #12]



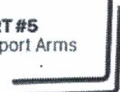
#7 To achieve desired location of windshield, adjustment of support arms [Part #5] and brackets [Part #2] is regained.

*Note this is a universal windshield kit and may take several adjustments to position properly on your ATV.

#8 Tighten all hardware at this point, paying attention not to over tighten

*Note before driving ATV operate all levers, throttle and handle bars to insure proper operation with no interference of windshield.
